

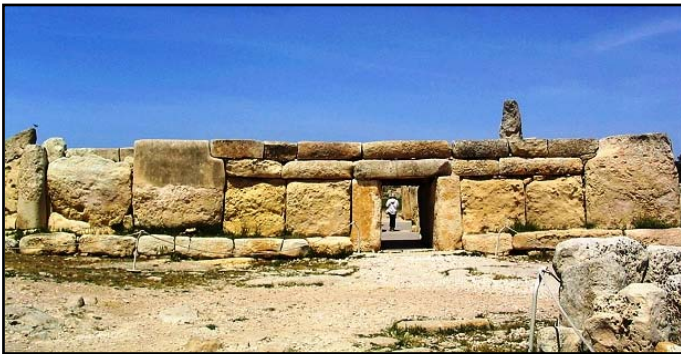
## Compare and Contrast

Unlike Hagar Qim, Stonehenge has a circular setting. ✓

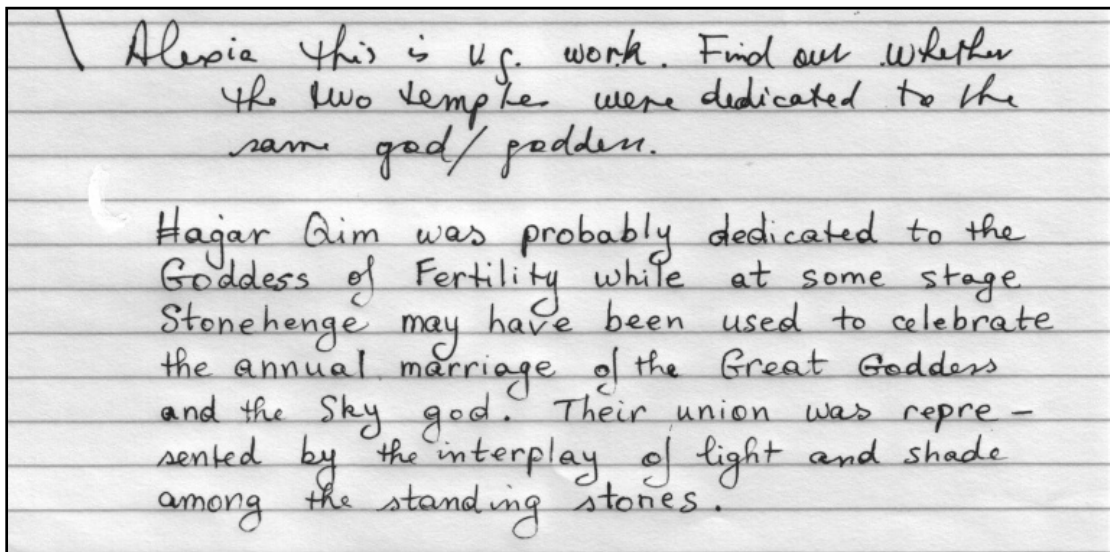
The teacher was pleased with the work of Alexia and in fact she told her:
